## **WSCA Legislative Update**

With five weeks left in the 2023 legislative session, committees were back in public hearings last week hearing and passing bills from the opposite chamber. Legislation must now advance in the opposite chamber, progressing through policy and fiscal committees and on to the full chamber to remain viable.

On Monday, the Washington State Economic and Revenue Forecast Council will release its latest revenue forecasts, which sets the stage for the proposed operating budgets to be released. The Senate will release its operating budget first this year, likely on Thursday (3/23), and a hearing is scheduled in the Ways & Means Committee on Friday (the capital budget will be released and heard Monday (3/20)). The House is expected to release their budget a week from Monday (3/27), and ultimately the differences between the two proposed budgets will be negotiated by a conference committee of budget writers from the House & Senate.

- WSCA Member Marin Marks testified last week in the Senate Early Learning & K-12 Committee in support of HB 1308, expanding graduation pathway options. The bill's sponsor, Rep. Monica Stonier, is working with stakeholders and members of the Senate Committee to address concerns raised in public testimony.
- The Education Committees in the House and Senate heard their respective funding proposals for special education last week, and both bills are scheduled to advance from policy committee this coming week. SB 5311 is the proposal being supported by most stakeholders to fund special education.
- E2SHB 1238, the bill to provide free school meals for students, was heard last week and is scheduled to be voted out of committee Monday. Although the bill has been significantly narrowed, it will still allow the state to feed roughly 600,000 students.
- This week the Senate committee will hear E2SHB 1479, concerning isolation & restraint of students.
